Technical Visit: National Air and Space Museum

There will be an opportunity to visit the National Air and Space Museum on 5 June 2024 from 3:30 to 5:30 PM.

NOAA will have timed-entry tickets for all registered participants.

COVID-19

As of May 2023, the United States ended the COVID-19 vaccine requirements for international air travelers. Noncitizen nonimmigrant air passengers no longer need to show proof of being fully vaccinated with an accepted COVID-19 vaccine to board a flight to the United States.



Weather for Washington, D.C.

In early June, morning low temperatures tend to be in the lower 60s F (15-17 C) with a few of the cooler mornings dipping into the mid-50s F (12-13C). Afternoon highs early in the month tend to be near 80F (26-27C).

While there is always a chance of rain, June is generally sunny or at least partially sunny. Thunderstorms are possible in the afternoons/evenings.

The <u>National Weather Service Forecast Office</u> <u>for Baltimore/Washington</u> has up-to-date forecasts, watches, and warnings.





Electricity

The United States uses type A and B power plugs and sockets (outlets). The standard voltage is 120 V at a frequency of 60 Hz.



Currency and Costs

The currency is the United States is the U.S. Dollar. ATMs are readily available around the city and most places will accept credit cards or mobile pay apps.

In the USA, taxes are generally added on top of the cost of any item. The general sales tax for Washington, DC is 6%; however, there are exceptions since groceries and medicine are not taxed. Meals and drinks at restaurants are taxed at 10%. Hotels add 15.95% tax to your stay.

Tipping

Americans tip for most personal services including in taxis and ride shares (Uber, Lyft); hotels (porters/bell hops, housekeeping, waitstaff and room service), and service in restaurants, bars and cafes. We've provided a quick guide to tipping below to help you plan your trip.

- Taxis & Ride Shares: 15 to 20% of the fare
- Restaurants: 20 to 25 % of the bill before sales tax. Some restaurants will add gratuity automatically for large parties. If the bill reads "gratuity included" or "service charge included" you are not required to pay extra.
- Hotels: Approximately \$2 per piece of luggage for porters and bell hops, and \$2 -\$5 per day for housekeeping depending on the room type, number of occupants, condition of your room and if you've made special requests.
- Bars: \$1-2 for each beer or wine and 15-20% for more complicated cocktails.



Getting Around Washington DC



Metro Rail

The Washington DC Metro System is open Monday through Thursday from 5 a.m. to midnight, Friday from 5 a.m. to 1 a.m., Saturday from 7 a.m. to 1 a.m. and Sunday from 7 a.m. to midnight. However, the first and last train service to Dulles Airport differ from the open and close time.

The closest metrorail stations to the CGMS-52 Venue (The Washington Plaza Hotel) are the McPherson Square Station (0.25 mi) on the Orange and Blue lines, and the Farragut North Station (0.51 mi) on the Red Line, and the Mt. Vernon Square – 7th Street Convention Center Station (0.59 miles) on the Yellow and Green Lines. The online TripPlanner is the best way to calculate your fare. You can enter an address or a metro station to begin your trip and an address or metro station to end your trip and it will provide

detailed directions, including walking directions to/from the station. TripPlanner is available in English, Chinese, French, Korean and several other languages.

<u>Metro fares</u> are calculated based on distance traveled and time of day. The TripPlanner will tell you the cost of each trip. Fare cards and passes as well as reloadable <u>SmartTrip Cards</u> are available for purchase at vending machines in the metro stations. You can also <u>add SmartTrip</u>

<u>in your Mobile Wallet</u> (Apple Wallet, Google Wallet) and use tap-and-go on your iPhone, AppleWatch or Adroid device.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If you are planning meetings with other NOAA representatives located in Silver Spring, MD – please note the Metro's Red Line will be stop at Fort Totten (before Silver Spring) and shuttle buses will be available. Alternatively, an express bus will depart Metro Center Metro Stop for Silver Spring. However, we recommend taking a taxi or Uber rather than taking the metro to Silver Spring that week.

The DC Circulator

The DC Circulator bus runs every 10 minutes and costs \$1 each way. Two bus stops are located within blocks of the hotel. 14th and K Street NW Stop (On 14th Street along Franklin Square Park) is on the Woodley Park - Adams Morgan - McPherson Square Line of the Circulator, and the K Street and 14th Street NW stop (on K Street west of 14th) is on the Georgetown-Union Station line. Taxis and ride shares (Uber, Lyft, Via) are abundant in Washington, D.C.


Capital Bike Share

The District's bike-sharing program makes bicycles available to anyone. Simply take a bike from one of over 165 stations in DC and Arlington, and return it to a nearby docking station. The closest docking station to the CGMS-52 venue is located on the opposite side of Thomas Circle from the hotel. Directions from Washington Dulles International Airport



Metro (Estimated travel time: 65 - 75 minutes)

The Metrorail station at Dulles (Silver Line) is connected to the main terminal by an indoor pedestrian tunnel with moving sidewalks. It is approximately a 5-minute walk from the terminal to the Metro station. Trains depart the stations approximately every 10 minutes during rush hour, every 12 minutes during off-peak hours, and every 15 minutes after 9:30 p.m.

After you exit the secure baggage claim area om the International Arrivals Building (Level 1) you will follow the signs for the Metro down a ramp the lower level and the indoor pedestrian walkway. You can purchase fare cards at the metro station or see the information above regarding SmartTrip and


Upon entering the Metrorail station.

- Follow the signs for the Silver Line/Largo.
- Take the Silver Line towards Largo (17 stops, ~51 minutes)
- Exit the Metrorail station following the signs for 14th and I Streets

- Take the escalator and exit via 14th Street NW & Zei Alley NW at the southeast corner
- Head North on 14th Street
- At the traffic circle, cross Massachusetts Avenue
- Turn right on the M Street NW
- Cross Massachusetts Avenue at the Circle
- Turn right on M Street to Enter the hotel which will be in front of you


Taxis (Estimated Travel Time: 45 minutes)

The airport is served exclusively by <u>Washington Flyer Taxicabs</u>. No reservations are needed for a taxi. Upon exiting the secure baggage claim area that services international arrivals, you will follow the signs for ground transportation to the lower level and exit via Door 2. You can pay by cash or credit card (American Express, Visa, Mastercard and Discover). Wheelchair accessible vehicles are available and service dogs are welcome. The <u>fare</u> to Washington, DC is approximately \$60 -75, but may be more at rush hour.



Ride App Pick Up (Estimated Travel Time: 45 minutes)

Uber and Lyft pick up and Washington Dulles International Airport. After you exit the secure baggage claim area, you will follow the signs down for Ride App Pickup, which will take you down a ramp to the lower level. You will follow the signs and then exit and cross to the 3rd curb. Numbered and lettered zones (3C-3F, with 3C closest to the International Arrivals building) make finding your ride easy.



Driving Directions (Estimated Travel Time: 45 minutes)

- Follow signs to exit the airport towards Airport Access Road.
- Stay straight to go onto Dulles Airport Access Road.
- Merge onto VA-267 East.
- VA-267 becomes I-66 East.
- Take the Independence Avenue exit.
- Stay straight to go onto US-50 East.
- Turn left onto 17th Street. NW.
- Turn right onto US-29/K Street NW.
- Stay straight to go onto 14th Street NW to Thomas Circle (a rotary).
- Exit Circle (rotary) at Vermont Avenue (the third exit), hotel entrance is on the right-hand side just off of the circle

Metro (Estimated Travel Time; 25 minutes)

The Washington, DC Metrorail system has an elevated Metrorail station connected to the concourse level of Terminal 2 Reagan National Airport. Metrorail farecards may be purchased at machines located at all entrances to the Airport Metrorail station. The station is also fully accessible via elevators. From Terminal 2: Use either of two enclosed pedestrian bridges on the concourse level which connect directly to the station. From Terminal 1: Exit the terminal to the street side curb, and board any "Airport Shuttle" bus. At the stops for Terminal 2 or North/South Parking 1 & 2, you can access an enclosed bridge which connects to the Metrorail station.


Upon entering the Metrorail station.

- Follow the signs for the metro station it is a short walk from the terminal via moving walkways
- Follow the signs for Blue Line/Largo, Yellow Line/Mt. Vernon Square
- Take the Blue line to McPherson Square (7 stops, ~15 minutes)
- Exit the Metrorail station following the signs for 14th and I Streets
- Take the escalator and exit via 14th Street NW & Zei Alley NW at the southeast corner
- Head North on 14th Street

- At the traffic circle, cross Massachusetts Avenue
- Turn right on the M Street NW
- Cross Massachusetts Avenue at the Circle
- Turn right on M Street to Enter the hotel which will be in front of you.

Taxis (Estimated Travel Time; 25 minutes)

Taxi service is on a first-come, first-served basis. A DCA Taxi Dispatcher is available at designated Taxi stands. Exit from the baggage claim level outside to the terminal curbside. You will find taxi dispatch locations clearly marked. All taxicabs accept cash or credit card. All taxicabs dispatched at Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport must have and use taxi meters. Wheelchair accessible vehicles are available and service dogs are welcome. Taxi Fares from the airport to the CGMS-52 are approximately \$20. Fares may be higher at rush hour.



RideShare (Uber, Lyft) (Estimated Travel Time; 25 minutes)

Uber and Lyft pick up at Reagan National Airport. Pickup locations for Terminals 1 and 2 are provided below. In the app, you'll be asked select the appropriate pick zone, and coordinate directly with their driver. Green flags located outside on the outer terminal curb designate the appropriate pick-up loading zones.

- Terminal 1: Customers can meet their ride on the third (outer) curb.
- Terminal 2: Customers can meet their ride on the Baggage Claim (Arrivals) Level -1st Floor on the outer curb. Please select Zone 1 through 4.

Driving Directions (Estimated Travel Time: 25 minutes)

- Exit the Airport North towards Airport Exit/I-395/GW Parkway North/US-50W/I-66/Washington.
- Merge onto George Washington Memorial (GW) Parkway North.
- Merge onto I-395 North/US-1 North toward Washington (crossing into District of Columbia).

- Keep left to take US-1 North via Exit 1 toward National Mall.
- Stay straight to go onto 14th Street NW to Thomas Circle (a rotary)
- Exit Circle (rotary) at Vermont Avenue (the third exit), hotel entrance is on the right-hand side just off of the circle.

Directions to Washington Dulles International Airport

Metro (Estimated Travel Time: 65 -75 minutes)

- Turn right on the M Street NW after you exit the hotel
- Cross Massachusetts Avenue at the Circle
- Continue south on 14th Street NW for three blocks
- Enter McPherson Square Metrorail Station (corner of 14th Street and I street)
- Follow signs for Silver Line/Ashburn
- Take the Silver Line to Washington Dulles International Airport (17 stops, ~50 minutes)
- Exit the metro station and follow the signs to the main terminal via the moving pedestrian walkways.

Taxi: If you would like to reserve a taxi to Washington Dulles Airport, you can +1-703-572-8294 to make a reservation for a Washington Flyer Taxi. They accept reservations at any time, however reservations placed 24-hours in advance are preferred to ensure vehicle availability and pick up in a timely manner. Non-Washington Flyer cab companies may drop off passengers at Dulles. It is easy to arrange a taxi through the hotel if you prefer.

Metro

- Turn right on the M Street NW after you exit the hotel
- Cross Massachusetts Avenue at the Circle
- Continue south on 14th Street NW for three blocks
- Turn right on I Street NW and walk one block to the McPherson Square Metrorail Station
- Follow signs for Orange Line Vienna/Blue Line Downtown Largo.
- Take the Blue Line to Ronald Reagan National Airport
- Follow signs for the Terminal
